**Notice of Apprenticeship**

**August 1, 2017**

The North Dakota Construction Craft Laborers' have a registered Apprenticeship Program.

QUALIFICATIONS: The minimum qualifications for Apprentices are:

1. Not less than eighteen (18) years of age.
2. Physically able and have the aptitude to perform the work of the trade.
3. Upon beginning work for an Employer, become a member of and maintain membership in good standing in the Laborers International Union pursuant to the governing Collective Bargaining Agreement.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Prior to acceptance in the apprenticeship program, an applicant must have secured, as a sponsor, an Employer who has provided to the JATC a written notice which states that the applicant has been hired or that the Employer intends to promptly hire the applicant. No written examination or interview is required by the JATC for entrance to the apprenticeship program

SPECIAL NOTE:

As an apprentice, "The Construction Laborers' Education, Training and Apprenticeship Fund of Minnesota and North Dakota will not discriminate against apprenticeship applicants or apprentices based on race, color, religion, national origin, sex (including pregnancy and gender identity), sexual orientation, genetic information, or because they are an individual with a disability or a person 40 years or older.
