Magnum Dedicated, Inc. was established in 2008 during an economic down turn. While many companies decided to cut back during the economic down turn, Magnum opted to look for new opportunities and created Magnum Dedicated to service customers with the need for a dedicated fleet operation.

Magnum's recent focus has been on infrastructure and growth. They continue to add to its extensive software systems with the latest in managing routes and equipment.

## AREA PROFILES

Area Profiles provide a quick and easy overview of a local area's labor market and economy by summarizing numerous primary and secondary sources of information.

They include industry employment and wages, unemployment and labor force statistics, initial unemployment claims, demographic data, workforce statistics, and taxable sales and purchases, just to name a few.

Ten years of historical data have been added for most data elements so visual trends can be spotted.

The profiles are updated monthly with the latest data, generally on the first working Wednesday of the month, though exceptions may occur.

They are available for all counties and the state.



Keep in mind, data are current as of the profile's scheduled monthly update.

Since data sources release their information at different times throughout a month or year, newer data may become available after an update but before the next scheduled update.

The profiles will reflect the newer data in the next scheduled update. Some data cannot be released due to reliability, availability, or confidentiality restrictions, especially for areas with small populations.
