We provide a variety of business services to help you make more informed decisions and grow your business. Best of all, there is no charge for the services we provide.

The ND Workforce Connection is the largest job board in North Dakota. As a Preferred Employer, your job openings will be at the "top of the list", ahead of other job postings that are posted on our job board from other websites. A Preferred Employer with Job Service is an employer who has a Job Service account, has been vetted, and has access to our services for free such as posting jobs and searching for candidates on our job board.

Job Service ND is your connection to North Dakota's workforce all across the state, whether that's online or inperson. Not only do we help with posting jobs, but we also help plan and host job fairs, assist with workforce training, On-the-Job Training, and apprenticeships. These services are available to businesses in surrounding counties outside of the Bismarck-Mandan area that fall within our service area.

The Bismarck Workforce Center provides regular rural outreach to the counties in our region: McLean, Mercer, Sioux, Kidder, Emmons, Sheridan, and Grant. Job Service staff visit our rural counties to support local employers and job seekers in meeting their workforce needs. Most of our visits occur on a monthly basis but arrangements can be made for virtual or in-person meetings.

## Parental Responsibility Initiative for the Development of Employment

The PRIDE Program helps non-custodial parents find and maintain employment to meet child support obligations and to attain self-sufficiency. PRIDE services are offered at Job Service for any parent who has a current court-ordered child support obligation or has past arrears due. Participants have access to case management and supportive services to assist them in finding employment. While working with the PRIDE Services Advisor, customers receive individualized employment services like job search assistance, skills assessment, job readiness assistance, transportation support, and more. Those interested in the program should contact their DHHS Child Support Worker and ask to be referred to the Job Service PRIDE program.
