# Capital Career Fair 2025: Connecting Job Seekers with Opportunities in Bismarck Region



The 2025 Capital Career Fair, hosted by the Bismarck Workforce Center, proved to be a remarkable event for job seekers and employers alike. Employers praised the event for the amount of foot traffic it generated, with one stating, "Great exposure for so many companies. Helps us be seen by some who may have never heard about our work." Another employer expressed appreciation for the variety of roles their company offered, saying, "We loved that people could fit into many of the roles that we offer." Other common sentiments included appreciation for the quality conversations employers had with job seekers, the well-organized setup, smooth flow of traffic, and the diversity of attendees, all contributing to a positive and productive experience for businesses and job seekers alike.

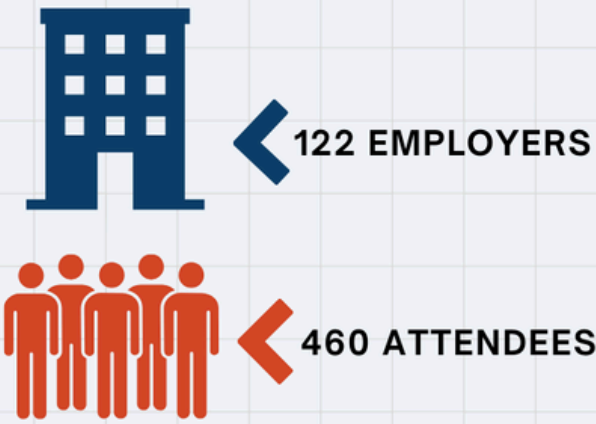

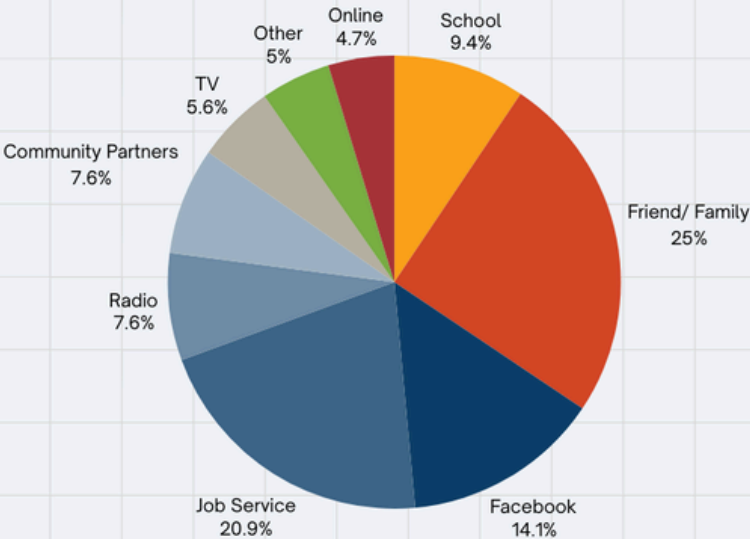
TOP 3 STUDENT PROGRAM ATTENDANCE



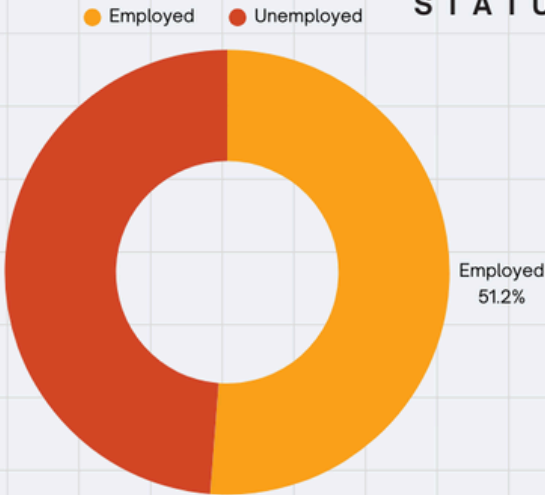
LOCATION OF ATTENDEES
