The Fargo Workforce Center is a premier facility that helps people find jobs and develop their careers. This can include financial assistance with classroom training, apprenticeship, on the job training, work experience, career exploration, assistance with job applications, support services, interviewing preparation, and overcoming obstacles to success.

At this very moment, the Fargo office is case managing/connecting 454 area residents to the local workforce through services like:

She grew up riding in her father's truck, so she has the support of her father and some knowledge of the career. She was so looking forward to this career as a CDL driver and was already researching what company she would like to work for before training was completed. Kayla is not only a success story but also someone to look up to as a CDL driver in a non-traditional occupation for a female. Kayla is a very hard-working person and now has a good job and financial stability. Her case worker, Kristin wishes her continued success.

We asked Kayla to share her thoughts about the WIOA Program and here is what she had to say:

"I can't thank Job Service ND enough! The WIOA program has truly changed my life. I have been struggling for years to work my way up the ladder at the various jobs I've held and I couldn't ever get to a place where I could comfortably afford my bills. And now with the help of Job Service I have more than DOUBLED my income. I never thought I would get to this point in my life where I didn't have to worry about how I was going to pay my bills. I'm so incredibly thankful for this opportunity. I couldn't have done it without the help of my Case Manager, Kristin Hanson. She was absolutely incredible. Once I told her I wanted to get my CDL, she was there every step of the way advocating for me. After I was accepted into a CDL training program, her excellence didn't stop there. There were some issues taking place at the facility I was attending and Kristin went out of her way to get in touch with the necessary people that were able to handle the situation. This was crucial because I didn't think I was going to be able to finish the training program with that outfit but she made sure those issues were addressed immediately! She's just been a great advocate for the people she helps on a daily basis and we need more people like that who will help you reach your dreams. You shouldn't have to do it alone and struggle, it takes a team! So thank you to everyone who made this possible. I am finally able to start paying off my debt and build a better life for myself."

2024 Virtual Job Fair Surpasses Expectations

2024 started off with a huge win for Job Service North Dakota! All nine workforce centers across the state collaborated to plan a Virtual Job Fair on January 18. There were 1,308 job seekers that registered to attend representing 23 states and 21 countries.

The 97 registered employers were able to set up their Virtual Booths to promote their open positions in high-demand, high wage positions in IT, UAS, Healthcare, Oil & Gas, Engineering, Skilled Trades,

Transportation, Manufacturing, Government, Education and Finance. Employers were excited to take advantage of our new 3D model. They were invited to set up their Virtual Booth, post their positions and then seek out job seekers and welcome those seekers to their booth to share information and resources and chat 1:1.

At the end of the event, we had a total of 634 job seekers attend. Of those, 330 were from North Dakota and other states and near 300 attended from oversees, including 286 form the Philippines. Those who attended were not sitting still. In fact, with all booths combined, there were a total of 3,914 booth visits and over 1,000 chats with employers. It was a great day!!

As of January, 2024 North Dakota had a total of 14,859 job openings. Events like our Virtual Job Fairs hope to attract people to our great state and help employers fill their positions with qualified applicants.
