Use SkillBridge to Recruit Separating Military Members

Tap into the unmatched work ethos service members bring to the workforce.



What is Skillbridge?

It is a job skills training program that permits military members to use up to the last 180 days of their service to train and learn with an industry partner. During their participation in Skillbridge, the service member will continue to receive their military compensation and benefits. Employers can craft a Skillbridge program to meet their specific work needs and tap into the experience, skills, and work ethos of military service members before they have completed their time in the military. You are not limited to recruiting service members currently stationed in North Dakota, Skillbridge allows you to advertise and recruit service members on military installations worldwide.

How to get started:

Your organization needs to have a clearly defined job training and career development program that would enhance employment skills, knowledge, and abilities for the service member and also ensure that there is a high probability of a job being availble for the participant upon completion of the program. You are not obligated to hire the individual once their Skillbridge is complete, however the goal of the program is sustainable, long-term employment, and show that your industry is in demand and has opportunities for professional advancement.

North Dakota Department of Commerce's Automation Tax Credit Program

The North Dakota Department of Commerce announced the 2023 Automation Tax Credit program, certified primary sector businesses stand to benefit from a tax credit of up to 15% for the acquisition or capital lease of machinery and equipment designed to automate manufacturing or animal agricultural processes within North Dakota. Should applicants require clarification on their primary sector certification status, assistance is available via email at ndead@nd.gov.

To be eligible, applicants must have taken ownership of the automation equipment during the 2023 calendar year. Additionally, businesses applying must have held primary sector certification both at the time of purchase and throughout the application process.

Once the completed application is received, it is reviewed by a team of reviewers and the Economic Development & Finance Director prior to submittal to the North Dakota Tax Department.

The Job Getting Unit in the Grand Forks Workforce Center assist job seekers in many ways getting them ready and connected with our businesses:

- General Resource Area Activities Computers are on-site for online applications, resumes, cover letters, career exploration, interview preparation, and any other workforce related needs. Experienced team members are available to assist as needed.
- <u>Hiring Events</u> Employers can use our office to host hiring events and promote their business, advertise job openings, screen potential candidates, collect resumes and assist seekers with completing their online applications.
- <u>Community Resource Fairs</u> We hold monthly fairs to connect our job seekers with additional community resources to ensure their employment success.
- <u>Reemployment Services Program</u> Offers individualized services to unemployment insurance claimants including education, training, and referrals leading to successful employment outcomes.
- <u>Parental Responsibility Initiative for the Development of Employment (PRIDE)</u> A program that helps non-custodial parents find and maintain employment to meet child support obligations and to attain self-sufficiency.
- <u>Job Seeker and Training Services</u> A variety of services including education, resume assistance, assessments, career guidance, and training which are designed to help individuals find employment.
- <u>Migrant Seasonal Farm Worker (MSFW) Outreach</u> Coordinate and provide outreach opportunities in an effort to reach the MSFW population and assist with job searching and training needs.
- <u>Veteran Serivces</u> Our staff provide individualized services to help Veterans overcome employment barriers and develop a plan for employment.
- <u>H2A Inspections</u> Coordinate and complete housing inspections with agricultural related employers who are hosting foreign workers under a work visa program.
- <u>Outreach</u> Connect with community partners, non-profit organizations, schools, and workforce related events to assist with job search, training and/or career exploration.
