#### LARGEST EMPLOYERS IN NORTH DAKOTA

Largest employer rankings are updated annually and based on the average number of payroll jobs reported to the Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages (QCEW) program. The QCEW program uses data from the unemployment insurance program which covers at least 90 percent of all employers in the state. Monthly jobs data are used to calculate an average annual employment number for each employer within a geographic area for the referenced calendar year and ranked. Private employers are then surveyed and asked to give their consent to publish their company as a large employer. If permission is not obtained, 'Nondisclosable' is substituted for the company name. Government entities are not surveyed since their data is automatically considered disclosable.
