



## Work Search and Registration Waiver Request

Claimants who are currently receiving Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) benefits may be eligible to have their work search and registration requirements waived if they are self-employed, a gig worker, or a contract worker. Individuals receiving PUA benefits who do not fall into these employment types are not eligible to receive a waiver of work search and registration requirements.

If you are self-employed, a gig worker, or a contract worker with the intent to resume your normal business operations and you desire a waiver of work search and registration requirements, complete and submit this form to Job Service. Your request will be reviewed to determine your eligibility for a waiver. You will receive a letter approving or denying your request for waiver.
